## RESOLUTION NO. 80-10 AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 116-06 & 77-10

## INCREASING THE CORONER'S SALARY TO BE EQUAL TO CERTAIN OTHER ELECTED OFFICIALS' SALARIES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that "... the Board of County Commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget...,"

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 states that "...the Board shall fix the compensation of all employees...,"

WHEREAS, the Coroner position was originally established as a part time position and the salary was set at approximately 75% of certain other elected officials,

WHEREAS, the Coroner position is now a full time position and the Commission has determined it is appropriate to establish the Coroner salary to be equal to that of the Assessor, Auditor, Clerk and Treasurer at \$68,130 annually.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, effective January 2011 the Board of Mason County Commissioners does hereby establish the Coroner salary at \$68,130 annually.
