WHEREAS the Sheriff's Office would like to honor the memory of Deputy Rick Glass who died in the line of duty in Mason County on March 9, 1985,


NOW THEREFORE, this Resolution names the building “The Deputy Rick Glass Public Safety Building” and authorizes a plaque be placed on the building.




