

SKOKOMISH FLOOD ZONE PROPERTY TAX LEVY
RESOLUTION NO. 79-13

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2014 and,

WHEREAS, the Skokomish Flood Zone's actual levy from the previous year was \$0; and

WHEREAS, the population of Mason County is more than 10,000; and now, therefore,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the taxing district that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2014 tax year.

There will be no request for a Property Tax Levy for 2014. The reduction from the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$0, which is a percentage increase of 0% from the previous year. This reduction is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refund made.




