WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. <u>70390</u>, known locally as the <u>North Shore Rd</u> and more specifically located in <u>Sec. 9, T. 22 N, R 2W, WM</u>, at approximately mile post <u>6.92</u>; work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Replace existing undersized culvert with a single structure that will carry flows under this critical roadway that serves the Tahuya Peninsula.

SAID WORK is to be performed by <u>Contract and/or County Forces</u> in accordance with Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County. (RCW 36.77.060 and/or RCW 26.77.065)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering: \$ 56,000 Right of Way \$ 20,000 Construction \$280,000

The County Road project herein described in HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with RCW 36.77.070 et. seq.
