

ORDINANCE NO. 35-15

REVISING SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT HOURS ON  
SAND HILL ROAD  
ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 90-06

**WHEREAS**, Sand Hill Elementary School is located on Sand Hill Road, County Road No. 86070, adjacent to Sand Hill County Park; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mason County Code No. 10.52.325 and RCW 46.61.440 designates that that a County may create a school speed zone in which it is unlawful to operate a vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty miles per hour

**WHEREAS**, Mason County previously established the speed limit for the school zone on Sand Hill Road on August 22, 2016 under Resolution 90-06.

**WHEREAS**, to be consistent with school and park activities the speed zone limit will be in effect, as shown:
