## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 55-87 AND REPLACING RESOLUTIONS 26-12 CHANGING THE SPEED LIMIT ON PICKERING ROAD IN MASON COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington RCW 46.61.415 permits local authorities to establish or alter maximum legal speed limits pursuant to RCW 46.61.400 on County road within their jurisdiction based on engineering and traffic investigation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 10.04 of the Mason County Code the board of county commissioners, by ordinance, may raise or lower a speed limit on any county road, except raising above fifty miles per hour.

WHEREAS, Mason County previously established alternate speed limits for the Pickering Road on July 21, 1987 under Resolution 55-87 and again on April 3, 2012 under Resolution 26-12.

WHEREAS, the Mason County Public Works Department has conducted an engineering and traffic investigation on Pickering Road; and

WHEREAS, County Commissioners held a public hearing and received public testimony regarding the speed limit on Pickering Road.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County Commissioner, after due deliberation and in the best interest of the public hereby adopts the speed limit posting for the entirety of Pickering Road as follows:
