SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the authorizations set forth in Section 1 of this resolution, designated departments shall endeavor to secure the most competitive price available for goods and services.

SECTION 4. Such authorization shall include unannounced entry and access onto and about private property, where such entry and access shall not violate those constitutional privacy and property rights under an emergency declaration.

SECTION 5. The emergency authority granted under **this resolution shall expire fourteen (14) days** from the date of the adoption of this resolution unless specifically authorized by the Board.
