

**MASON COUNTY 2017 ROAD PROPERTY TAX LEVY
RESOLUTION NO. 86-16**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2017 and,

WHEREAS, the Road Fund (District's) actual levy from the previous year was \$7,768,475.97 (pre-levy shift amount \$9,592,475.97) and,

WHEREAS, the population of Mason County is more than 10,000; and now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the taxing district (Road) that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2017 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$1,824,000 (\$0 pre-levy shift) which is a percentage increase of 23.4795% (0% pre-levy shift) from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, solar, biomass, and geothermal facilities, and any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.


This resolution reserves unutilized levy for banked capacity.


