A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES FOR THE FOLLOWING MASON COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS: AUDITOR, ASSESSOR, CLERK, CORONER, TREASURER; COMMISSIONERS; SHERIFF REPLACING RESOLUTIONS 73-15, 56-15 and 77-10

WHEREAS, RCW 36.17.020 states "The county legislative authority of each county ... is authorized to establish the salaries of the elected officials of the county...;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Commissioners establish the salaries of the Auditor, Assessor, Clerk, Coroner, Treasurer and Sheriff and they recognize the importance of establishing the salaries of the elected officials at a competitive level;

WHEREAS, historically the salaries of the Auditor, Assessor, Clerk, Coroner and Treasurer have been established at 95% of the Commissioners' salary and the Sheriff's salary has been established at 22% above the Elected Officials' salary;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, commencing in 2017, to establish the Auditor, Assessor, Clerk, Coroner, and Treasurer (Elected Officials) salaries at 95% of the highest paid Mason County Commissioner and establish the Sheriff's salary at 22% above the Elected Officials' salaries.
