RESOLUTION NO. 98-16
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 87-16 TO FIX THE AMOUNT OF AD VALOREM
TAXES FOR THE ROAD LEVY FOR THE YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.090 states that the Board of Mason County Commissioners shall fix the amount of the tax levies to be raised for Road Fund;

WHEREAS, the Diversion of Road Levy was adopted at \$1,380,000 at the November 22, 2016 hearing and that amount needs to be recertified at \$1,500,000;

IT IS THEREFORE DETERMINED, that the following be fixed as the amounts to be raised by ad valorem taxes for the purpose of meeting the expenditures estimated in the 2017 Budget for Mason County Refund Levy and Road Fund:

ROAD FUND	\$ 8,148,706.49
DIVERSION OF ROAD LEVY	<u>\$ 1,500,000.00</u>
TOTAL ROAD LEVY	\$ 9,648,706.49
REFUND LEVY	<u>\$ 29,614.01</u>
TOTAL AMOUNT TO LEVY FOR 2017	<u>\$ 9,678,320.50</u>

This resolution reserves unutilized levy for banked capacity.


